

# Fire Extinguisher Disposal Service

---

We understand that the safe disposal of fire extinguishers isn't a simple process. The correct handling, storing, emptying, disposing, and recycling of units is a complex operation.

## Service Offering

Please see the following safety protocols that must be adhered to in order to use the CheckFire Fire Extinguisher Disposal Service.

- **All scrap fire extinguishers, both pressurised or unpressurised, must be pinned and tagged prior to being collected or dropped off to our recycling facility.**
- **Scrap that is booked through our collection service must be returned in a CheckFire Transport Crate complete with all collars\* following the below process:**
  - **Each pallet must be safely secured with a minimum of the 3 x collars provided by CheckFire**
  - **Using the second pallet provided by CheckFire, please place it on top to secure the overall crate of scrap fire extinguishers**
  - **Finally, please sufficiently wrap the entire crate with pallet wrap to ensure complete security of the load**
- **Extinguisher Disposal Count Record is completed and returned with scrap units.**
- **We accept scrap fire extinguishers and fire extinguisher cardboard boxes only.**

Due to safety reasons, we will be unable to accept or process any scrap that does not comply with these points. We thank you for your understanding and support.

*\*Transport crates must be returned with all three collars. A fee of £10 per collar will be charged for incomplete collars.*
